#### **Action Items**

- Formed the Mutual Ministry Committee with members Terri Shoquist, Wanda Khor, Patti Menza, and Steve Faust, and with Michelle Carlson and John Kelm as the church council members of the committee.
- Accepted the proposed 2023-2024 Church Event Calendar.
- Approved purchase of a new coffee brewer for the kitchen in an amount up to \$3,116.25 with funds coming from the designated for kitchen and capital.
- To Keep the offering procedure the same as last approved by the council; to offer communion at the rail during the Praise and Worship service and offer continuous distribution of communion during all other services.
- To continue with Pastor Ryan Flunker's bible study until a new pastor is called. After the new pastor has been hired and established, the group will be welcome to ask the council to start meeting once again at Our Saviour's.

- To post the number for Light at the Inn in the glass doors of the Crystal Lake entrance to the church. The sign will be visible from the outside announcement of its posting will be in the bulletin.
- To have the building committee look into shimming the pew racks so all books can fit and also make repairs to the pew racks that are broken.
